

## **Driving directions from Rodez Airport to Le Peyratel.**

Distance – approx. 60km/37miles.

Driving time – 45mins to 1 hour.

On leaving the Airport, turn left at the roundabout onto the D840 towards Aurillac and Decazville. On some older maps, this road may be marked as the N140 as the road has been recently upgraded and reclassified.

Stay on this road for approx. 30km/19 miles when you will come to a series of three roundabouts as the road takes you around the town of Decazville.

Go straight across the first two roundabouts (signed Aurillac or Autres Directions) and at the third, turn right (signed Aurillac and also Maurs) onto the D963.

After 22km/14 miles you will come to the town of Maurs (you may notice that the road number has now changed to the D663 as you have crossed the departmental border between Aveyron and The Cantal).

As you approach the town, go straight across a small roundabout, across the railway line (automatic level crossing) and up a small hill to a T-junction.

Turn right at this junction, drive past a water fountain to a second fountain at the T-junction with the N122. Turn left onto this main road and almost immediately right onto the D319 signed Saint Cirgues. This small turning, although signposted, is easy to miss as it goes through a gap between a bar and a shop.

The D319 takes you up a hill out of the town and after about a mile you enter the trees and the road winds its way down the valley to a bridge crossing a small river – The Veyre, which makes the departmental boundary between The Cantal and The Lot.

Follow the road (which now becomes the D29) over the bridge and wind up the other side of the valley. Some 6km/3.75 miles after leaving Maurs, you come quite suddenly out of the trees and ahead of you on the skyline about half a mile ahead you see a square house.

On reaching the cross roads where this house is situated, turn right – you will see a sign for Le Peyratel on this junction. Continue to the second left turn – another Peyratel sign here – and we are about 200 yards on the left.
